Transport and handling safety is very important in a food factory as lot's of accidents are caused by transport and handling incidents.





Transport incidents include:

- Being hit by a vehicle
- Being run over by a vehicle
- Being stuck by an object





Handling incident include:

- Crushing
- Entrapment
- Loads collapsing
- Compromise of food safety
- Strains, sprains and back injuries
- Slip, trips and falls
- Dropping loads on people or yourself





Transport and handling accidents can be caused by:

- Forklift trucks
- Handling equipment e.g. pallet trucks
- Despatch vehicles
- Poor use of ladders and lifts
- Poor factory layout
- Manual handling techniques
- Untidy work area



Food factory management make sure transport and handling safety is monitored and followed by:

- Safe workplace layout
- Appropriate training is given to all staff
- Wear PPE and use suitable equipment and machinery correctly
- Park vehicles safely and remove keys when necessary
- Safe working practice
- Regular maintenance checks and repair/replacement
- Ensure operators are competence and qualified
- No unauthorised work practices occur



If possible avoid using ladders, but if they are used they should be used on a stable, level work surface. A visual check of the ladder should be performed.





Manual handling of objects must be done in a safe way to ensure no accidents or injuries occur. All staff receive manual handling training.
