The local Council is 'The Licensing Authority'

Hold hearings when there are problems with the application or Police concerns.





The local Council is 'The Licensing Authority'

Create a policy which highlights the law in simple terms for everyone involved to follow





Responsible authorities

Help to make judgments on licences, they are:

- Chief of police
- Fire authority
- Health and safety authority





Responsible authorities

- Local planning authority
- Environmental health department
- Child protection agency
- Weights and measures authority





Interested party or parties

Also help the Council make decisions on licensing.

- A person living in the vicinity of the premises
- A body representing persons who live in the vicinity





Objectives of licensing

- Prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety





Objectives of licensing

- Prevention of public nuisance
- Protection of children from harm





Operating schedule outlines

- Documentation that outlines what activities are proposed
- When and where these activities will take place
- Opening hours
- How the activities will be managed
