Preparing Orders

When preparing an order for despatch the correct customer order documentation must be checked.

This will state what product and how much is required.

A check on the availability of the product must be performed.





Preparing Orders

Documentation also states the correct date code of product to be used in the order.

This is important as the customer will reject the order if it has the wrong date code e.g. it will become out of date before reaching the customer's store.





The area must be checked to ensure there is enough clear space for the order to be moved safely to the despatch vehicle.



Despatch operatives then prepare to pick the order by selecting the appropriate equipment for moving the product to the despatch vehicle.



There are four ways of moving product orders:

Forklift truck/electric forklift

Pallet truck

Crane or hoist

Conveyor



The two most popular ways of moving a pallet of product or containers of product is with a pallet truck or a forklift truck.





A pallet truck is used to move product at ground level and a forklift truck can move product stored at a height as well as ground level. A forklift truck is the best devise to use if there is a large distance that the product needs to be moved.



Some factories have an automated system where robots select the product and move them to their desired position to be despatched.





All moving equipment should be checked before use to make sure it is working correctly.



The location of the product required for the order should be checked.

Some factories despatch departments can be very large so a system is used to trace where every product is stored within the department e.g. aisle13 section 8.
